What is a Podcast

A podcast is a program (as of music or talk) made available in digital format for automatic download over the Internet.

The word is derived from "broadcast" and "pod" from the success of the iPod, as audio podcasts are often listened to on portable media players.

What is a Webcast

A webcast is a media presentation distributed over the Internet using streaming media technology to distribute a single content source to many simultaneous listeners/viewers.

A webcast may either be distributed live or on demand. Essentially, webcasting is "broadcasting" over the Internet.
